However we request that a variation of the S106 agreement is considered by reducing the % of affordable housing which is higher than the new Local Plan and higher than the level identified in the Parish Needs Survey which has already been surpassed. There are many community projects within High Ercall which would benefit from extra S106 funding by such a reduction.
